1. Purpose

To outline the expected standards of behavior, discipline, and professionalism of athletes representing Judo Trinidad and Tobago (JudoTT), both domestically and internationally.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all athletes selected to the National Judo Team, including those in training, competition, or representing Team TTO in any capacity.

3. Core Values

Respect: For teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents.

Integrity: Demonstrate honesty and sportsmanship in all situations.

Discipline: Adhere to training, competition, and travel guidelines.

Pride: Represent JudoTT and Trinidad and Tobago with dignity.

4. Responsibilities

Athletes must:

Attend all scheduled national training sessions unless excused in writing.

Maintain appropriate conduct on and off the mat.

Wear approved **Team TTO uniforms and IJF-compliant Judogi**.

Communicate promptly regarding injuries or absences.

Refrain from alcohol, drugs, or any banned substances.

Abide by JudoTT Anti-Doping and Fair Play Policy [POL-ETH-202510-012].

Maintain good standing with their club and JudoTT membership.

5. Disciplinary Actions

Violations of this Code may result in:

Verbal or written warnings.

Temporary suspension from training or competition.

Removal from the national team.

Referral to the JudoTT Executive for further action.

6. Reporting and Resolution

All incidents or breaches must be reported in writing to the National Coach or Team Manager.

A review will be conducted according to the **JudoTT Disciplinary Procedure**.
