



Anti-Doping and Fair Play Guidelines

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Ratified By	Member Clubs
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1. Purpose

To ensure all athletes, coaches, and officials uphold the principles of fair play and comply with anti-doping regulations as set by the IJF and WADA.

2. Scope

Applies to all individuals participating in JudoTT-sanctioned training, competitions, or national team activities.

3. Anti-Doping Policy

- Athletes must not use prohibited substances or methods.
- Compliance with WADA and IJF anti-doping regulations is mandatory.
- Random drug testing may be conducted during training camps and competitions.

4. Fair Play Principles

- Respect referees, opponents, and officials.
- Avoid cheating, intimidation, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Promote integrity, honesty, and equitable competition.

5. Education and Awareness

- JudoTT will provide anti-doping education for athletes and coaches.
- Coaches must ensure athletes understand substances, supplements, and medication rules.

6. Sanctions

Violations may result in:

- Warning or reprimand
- Suspension from training or competition
- Disqualification from events
- Referral to JudoTT Executive Committee or IJF

7. Review

Annual review by the National Coach, Executive Committee, and Ethics Officer.

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
